

**VILLAGE OF GRAFTON**  
**PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING**  
**2019 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**  
**MONDAY, APRIL 8, 2019**

An informational meeting was held regarding the 2019 Street Improvement Project. The 2019 Street Improvement program includes 17th Avenue (Washington Street to 250 feet south of Spruce Street), Dellwood Court, Cedar Street (16th Avenue to 17th Avenue), Bridge Street (15th Avenue to 17th Avenue), and 16th Avenue (Bridge Street to Bridge Street).

The project consists of relaying sanitary sewer, water main, water services, concrete curb repairs or replacement, new roadway gravel base, and repaving the roadway. There is no cost or special assessments to Village property owners for this street improvement.

17th Avenue: The project will begin this week. Barricades have been placed and detours have been set. Completion with the first layer of asphalt should be done by the end of June. The road is wide enough to accommodate a bike lane; therefore, that may be incorporated.

Bridge Street and 16th Avenue: Full curb and gutter replacement on the south side of the road. The road will be narrowed slightly therefore driveway aprons will be done on the south side of the road as well.

Cedar Street and Dellwood Court: The road will be narrowed by three feet on both sides; therefore, all new curb and gutter will be completed and new driveway approaches will be completed. This part of the project is anticipated to begin approximately mid-May.

Many residents on the project asked questions about services during the project:

- Brush Collection: Yes, the Village will provide the service as needed.
- Garbage/Recycling Collection: Contractor will collect on the streets under construction first thing in the morning; all carts should be at the curb before 7:00 AM.
- Mail service and mailbox relocation: The mail carrier should be able to get through to deliver mail. If there is an issue the contractor will move all mailboxes to the end of the project. On the streets that are narrowed the mailboxes will be relocated by the contractor at the completion of the project.
- Village trees that were removed will be replanted at some point in the future.
- Access and parking: All property owners will have access to their property during the entire project with the exception of when concrete is poured and curing time. Parking on the street will be permitted after the contractor is done for the day.

- Construction hours are 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM.
- Notices for interruption in service or to remove cars from the driveway will be done with as much notice as possible, typically the day before. This will be done with flyers or door hangers. Please check your door on a regular basis during construction.
- If additional lateral work is needed past the right-of-way it would be at the expense of the property owner.
- Restoration will be completed at the end of the entire project.
