**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO MAIL PUBLIC HEARING NOTICES
VIA FIRST CLASS MAIL**

WHEREAS, the Village of Grafton Zoning Ordinance states that "Notice of the public hearing shall be mailed to all parties-in-interest at least ten (10) days before the hearing. Parties-in-interest shall be defined as the petitioner, the clerk of any municipality within one thousand (1,000) feet of any lands included in the petition, and the owners of all lands included in the petition and all lands lying within two hundred (200) feet of lands included in the petition."; and

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk, on behalf of the Plan Commission, mails public hearing notices via certified mail for all conditional use permits and rezonings (including Planned Unit Developments); and


WHEREAS, mailing public hearing notices via certified mail has become onerous for applicants and Village staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of the Village of Grafton directs the Village Clerk to mail Plan Commission public hearing notices via first class mail.
