Pool Rental Guidelines

1. The Parks and Recreation Department will provide all necessary personnel to operate and ensure a safe facility for the size of the group. Pool staff has the authority to cancel a reservation due to weather conditions and/or for the health and safety of the group.
2. One adult chaperone (18 or older) must be present during the rental.
3. Arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to rental start time. All patrons must exit the facility no later than 15 minutes after the rental. Permit Holder is responsible for any set up, clean up and orderly condition of the facility upon their departure.
4. Water toys are welcome. For safety reasons, inflatables may be allowed or prohibited at the Pool Manager's sole discretion.
5. Only one person at a time may ride down the slide. Parents are not allowed to accompany children down the slide.
6. Patrons who are not toilet-trained are required to wear swim diapers or rubber pants (over cloth diapers) in addition to a swim suit.
7. Food and beverages may be brought in during the pool rental. Electrical outlets are available. A refrigerator is available to use, however, there is limited freezer space for storing perishable items. Food and beverages must be kept and consumed under the shelter in the concession area. Balloons, decorations, games and party favors are welcome. Glass containers, alcohol products and grills are prohibited.
8. The pool will remain open for a rental if it is lightly drizzling/raining. If severe weather exists prior to your rental start time, a Pool Manager will contact you with options for the rental (i.e., reschedule or delay opening of pool). If a Manager determines that inclement weather threatens a rental and the date cannot be rescheduled, a full refund will be issued.
9. Smoking is not allowed within the pool facility. Animals are not permitted within the pool facility.
10. Any live, amplified music is prohibited. A radio is available. A CD player may be brought in to play appropriate musical selections. No electrical cords are allowed on deck.
11. Permit Holder is responsible for the behavior of the group and must be present for the entire duration of the rental period. Running and rough play, including but not limited to, dunking, pushing, riding on shoulders, and spitting of water is not allowed. Use of foul language will result in being ejected from the pool facility. Admission will be refused to any person under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance. Disorder amongst patrons may be grounds for cancellation and subsequent denial of future permits.
