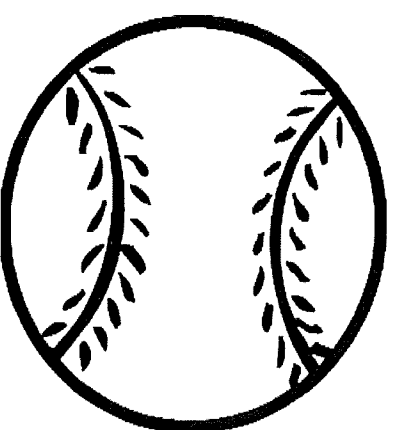

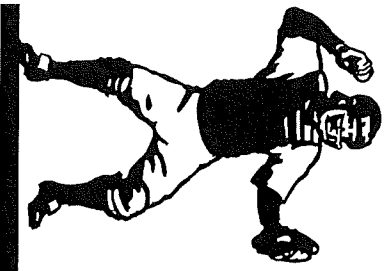

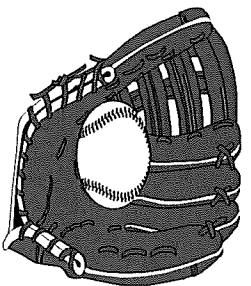

- Senior Ozaukee Softball was started in 1990 by a team from Grafton that was competing in the Wauwatosa League.
- In 1991, the Grafton League was established with four teams participating. The league quickly grew to six teams by 1992.
- As many as 98 seniors have participated in a year
- Teams are formed by a draft procedure designed to avoid cliques and promote fellowship.

Our League is Organized and Based on the Following Philosophy

Basic Rules and Guidelines

- Minimum age is 55.

 - Games are held on Thursdays, holidays excluded, at Centennial Park ball field in Grafton.
 - Games start at 6:00 p.m.
 - There are about 13 players on a team and everybody plays.
 - Safety is utmost, no collisions or sliding.
 - Entry fee is \$45.00 which includes the banquet fee.
